Trust me with your whole heart so I can guide your steps **Proverbs 3:5**

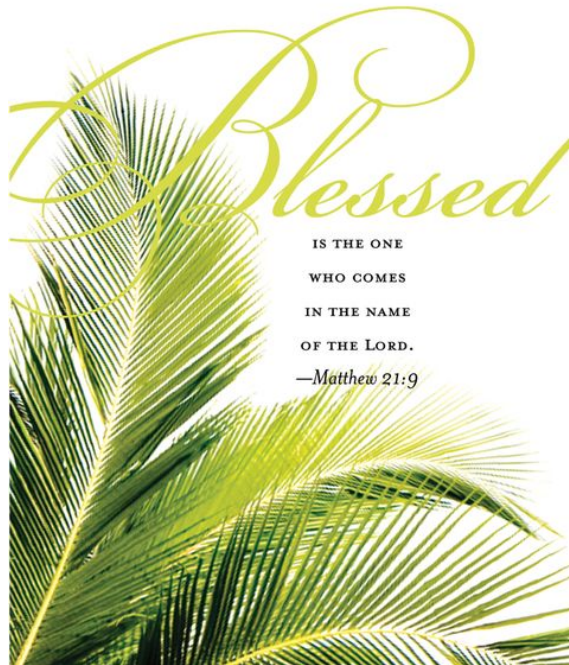
I- INVITE OTHERS TO KNOW HIM TOO.

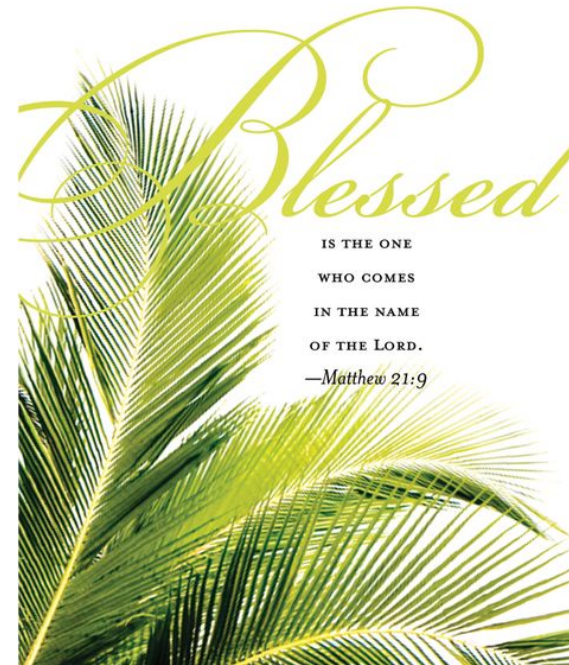
